2. Executive Director of Clean Aire, Jeffrey Robbins
 - a. Focused on climate change and environmental justice advocacy on behalf of communities
 - b. EPA standard reduced to 9ppm – we see spiking during holidays
 - c. Environmental justice dashboard – “airkeepers” given access to their monitors and monitors in their area
 - d. Saturday, October 19th listening session at UNCC Dubois center
3. Tree Charlotte, Joi Mayo
 - a. Expanding canopy and tree care – can help with ivy and vines year round
 - b. Application have closed – but being reviewed on a rolling basis
 - c. Tree assessments are free for all
 - i. Treesilience - Free personal tree work AMI of <8%
 - ii. Mature tree canopy and planting
 - d. October 1st workshop in person at the church and will start consultations in late October
4. HDC Updates
 - a. Before you cut any trees – you need formal arborist review and you need permission
 - b. Allows solar panels but you need approval
 - c. Full review is a 6 month back log
 - d. Link to HDC on our website
 - e. National registry nomination takes 2 years – could be Spring of 2026 and same for Oaklawn Park
